At County level he had fully established himself in the senior team and was due to represent Cornwall at the South West Counties Championship in June. Ben who had just turned 19 years of age had also enjoyed years of success representing Cornwall Junior's with distinction and was a former SW Boys Champion.

Although Ben will be remembered for his golfing achievements for those who knew him he was a pleasant young man who just loved to play golf and who took pride in representing his Country, County and Club.

A few words cannot sum up sadness that we feel and many of us will find it difficult to come to terms with what has happened.
